

Bacco Ristorante cuts prices on menu

Bacco Ristorante in Southfield, one of metro Detroit's best restaurants, has dropped its menu prices by as much as half for some dishes, while reducing portions to amounts more in keeping with traditional Italian dining, chef-owner Luciano del Signore said today.

"Our customers can now enjoy a three-course meal for the same price as what a full entrée was previously," he said. While portions and prices will be smaller, quality will remain unchanged, he said.

Entrée plates will continue to include a starch and two vegetables, and the menu will still feature deluxe ingredients such as "Piemontese beef filet, veal tenderloin, high quality seafood and decadent desserts."

Del Signore said he will also introduce half-pours of wine — at half the price of a full glass — so patrons can sample more wines throughout the meal.
